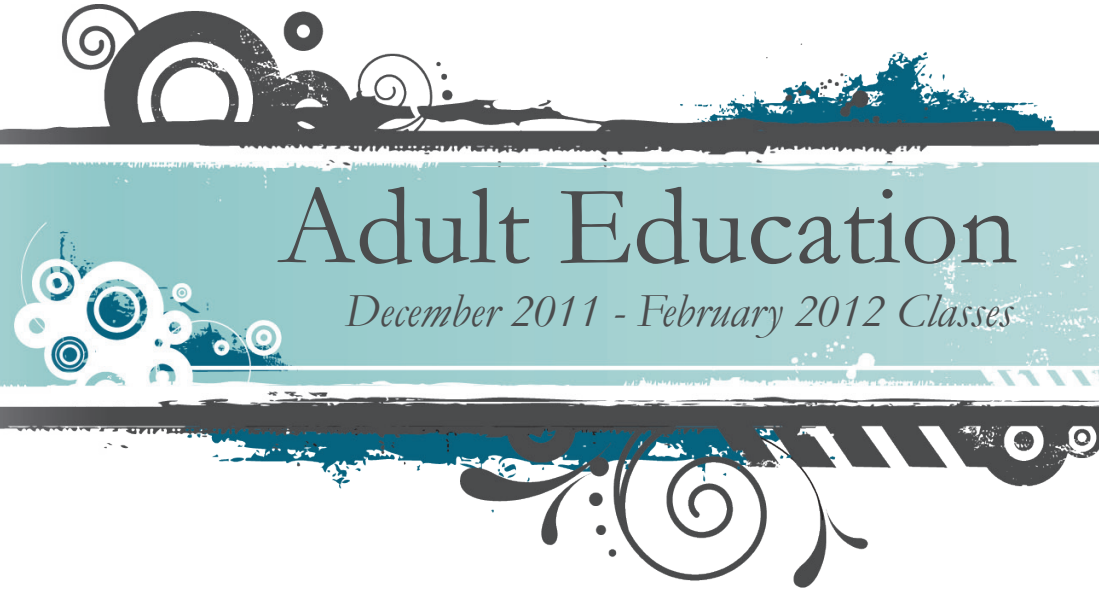

An opportunity for men to gather for a time of prayer in the middle of the week.

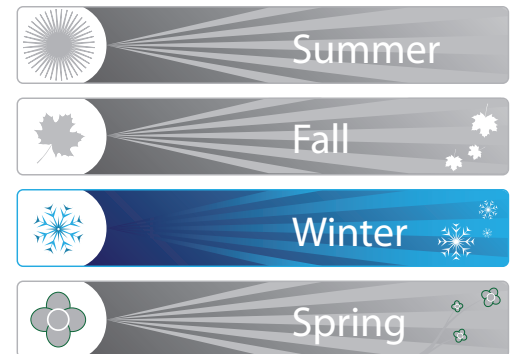
